Grandfriends will enjoy:

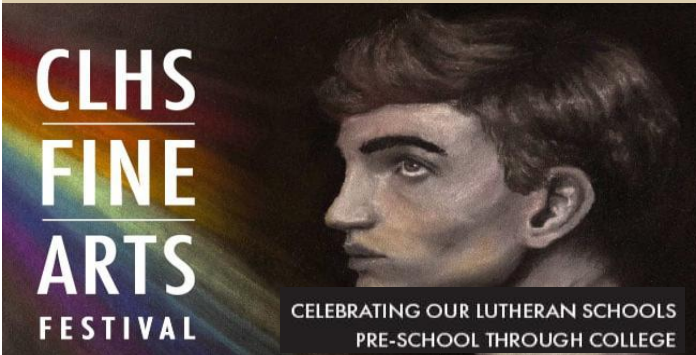

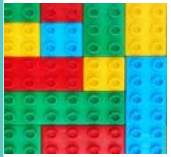


Tuesday, March 17th, 4:00 PM-5:00 PM: Mindful Meditation—Dual Doodling
