Learn Not to Burn

Recently, LSUS had the privilege of hosting the **Learn Not to Burn** program, an important fire safety initiative for young students. Kindergarten through 2nd grade and 4th grade students participated in this engaging program designed to teach important fire safety skills. **Learn Not to Burn** is a nationally recognized fire safety curriculum that begins in preschool and continues through fifth grade, with each year's lessons building on what students learned previously. As children grow older, the lessons progress accordingly, reinforcing key safety concepts and helping students understand the importance of following fire safety rules.

While the program focuses primarily on fire safety, students also learned about the role of firefighters and the protective gear they wear. Through interactive activities and discussions, students explored essential safety topics such as stop, drop, and roll; staying away from fire and hot objects; recognizing good fire versus bad fire; smoke detector awareness; planning home fire escape routes; proper use of 911; identifying fire hazards at home; burn prevention; and personal responsibility. This program helps equip our students with practical knowledge and confidence to stay safe both at school and at home.

Wednesday, April 8th, 4:30-5:30PM: Painting An Amazon Rainforest **Recommended for: Grade 4th-6th**

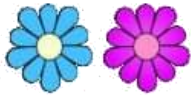
